Subject: Amendment in Recruitment Rules for the post of Controller of Publications at Dept. of Publication, Delhi - Regarding.



NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 16th June, 2022

G.S.R.- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Department of Publication, Government of India (Controller of Publications) Recruitment Rules, 2015 published in the Gazette of India, Part-II, Section 3, Sub-section (i), dated the 11th June, 2015 except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Controller of Publications in the Department of Publication in the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement.-

- (a) These rules may be called the Department of Publication, Controller of Publications, Recruitment Rules, 2022.
- (b) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification pay band and grade pay or pay scale.

– The number of the said post, its classification and the pay band and grade pays/pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualifications, etc.- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.- No person,-

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government, may, if satisfied, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen, Other Backward Classes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

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Note 2: For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2016/the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Seventh Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding pay / pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Pay Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post (s) for which that grade pay/pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.

Note 3: Deputation / Re-employment of Armed Force Personnel:

The Armed Forces personnel of the rank of Lt. Colonel or equivalent who are to be transferred to reserve within a period of one year and having the qualifications and experience prescribed for deputation shall also be considered. Such persons would be given deputation terms upto the date on which they are due for release from the Armed Forces; thereafter they may be continued on re-employment.
